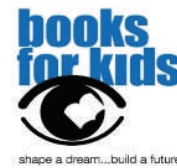

Books Donated to BFK Libraries

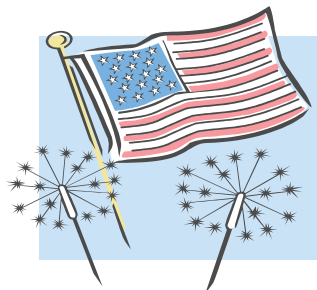
